# STUDIO REMINDERS

Please take a moment to read our studio reminders to ensure a fun and safe environment for all students.

**ARRIVING ON TIME:** Students should arrive at the studio a few minutes prior to scheduled class time dressed in proper code with hair tied back or in a ballet bun (see below). We want to avoid entering class when it is already in progress as it is disruptive to the teachers and students.

**CLOSED LOBBY:** Dance & Company's lobby remains closed for class observation. For classes in the front studio, you are able to watch from the outside and, we will continue to offer Zoom observation for the back studio. Our Front Desk staff will be able to provide you with the Zoom link, which remains constant week-to-week.

**DRESS CODE:** Please click here to read through our dress code. We would like to remind our dancers that it is MANDATORY to follow all details of our dress code while participating in class. For every class, dancers must have their hair pulled back out of their faces. for Ballet Intro and above, a ballet bun is required.

### **PARKING LOT PROTOCOL & SAFETY:**

- A reminder that the front-facing parking spots are to be used for quick drop-off or pick-up only. We do have three signs in front of Dance & Co. labeled "Dancer Drop-Off Only" during our prime hours, but we do remind parents to clear these spots as quickly as possible. If these spots are occupied we ask that you pull into a spot in the center of the lot while waiting for your dancers, please do not block the lot while waiting for a spot to clear.
- For our combo and mini-aged dancers, we ask that you walk to the front of the studio lobby where you will meet your dancers once released.
- Safety of our dancers (at any age) is our utmost priority so please do not expect your dancer to find you in the parking lot.
