Dance & Company Dress Code - *Effective January 1, 2026*

General Class Guidelines for all Classes/Students

- Hair must be pulled back and secured off the face.
- No dangling or loose jewelry.
- All clothing must be appropriate for a group dance class and physical activity; attire should allow for movement without revealing undergarments or excessive skin.
- Studio merchandise is always considered class-appropriate.
- Refer to the studio class key to find your class name and corresponding dress code below

Combo Classes

- Leotard (skirted or not) and pink or tan dance tights. Optional: dance shorts
- Shoes: Pink ballet slippers and black tap shoes or black jazz shoes.

Technique Classes

Ballet (All Levels, Except Combo Classes & Adults)

- Hair secured in a ballet bun
- Black leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet slippers.
- Optional: black ballet skirt or black dance shorts over the leotard.
- Cold weather: Wrap sweaters or shrugs are allowed; bulky sweatshirts are not.
- Note: Leotards that don't meet the ballet dress code can still be worn for other classes (Jazz, Contemporary, rehearsals, workshops, etc.)

Males (Combos + Technique)

Black bottoms, white T-shirt, black ballet shoes.

Jazz & Contemporary

- Black shorts, leggings or appropriate dance pants.
- Top of your choice. Sports bras/leotards recommended under loose fitting tops.
- Black jazz shoes or half soles (we recommend alternating so you are familiar with dancing in both).

Tap

- Dancewear or fitted athletic wear that allows movement and expression.
 - o If wearing a skirt or dress, shorts must be worn underneath.
- Black tap shoes

Elective Classes

Musical Theatre

- Dancewear or fitted athletic wear that allows movement and expression.
 - o If wearing a skirt or dress, shorts must be worn underneath.
- Students may follow the dress codes listed above for Ballet, Combo, or Jazz.
- Black jazz shoes are required.

Hip Hop

- Comfortable, loose-fitting clothing that allows full range of movement; no jeans or restrictive clothing.
- Clean sneakers required

Adult Program - ages 18+

You are welcome to wear either:

- **Comfortable, movement-ready attire:** Clothing such as leggings, tanks, or T-shirts that allows full range of motion. Attire should be suitable for a group dance class setting and should not reveal undergarments or excessive skin.
- Traditional ballet attire: Leotard with tights, optional skirt or dance shorts.
 - Teens (17 and under) enrolled in our adult program, please follow the standard dress code above.
- **Shoes:** Ballet slippers or grippy socks.
- **Hair:** Pulled back and secured off the face.
